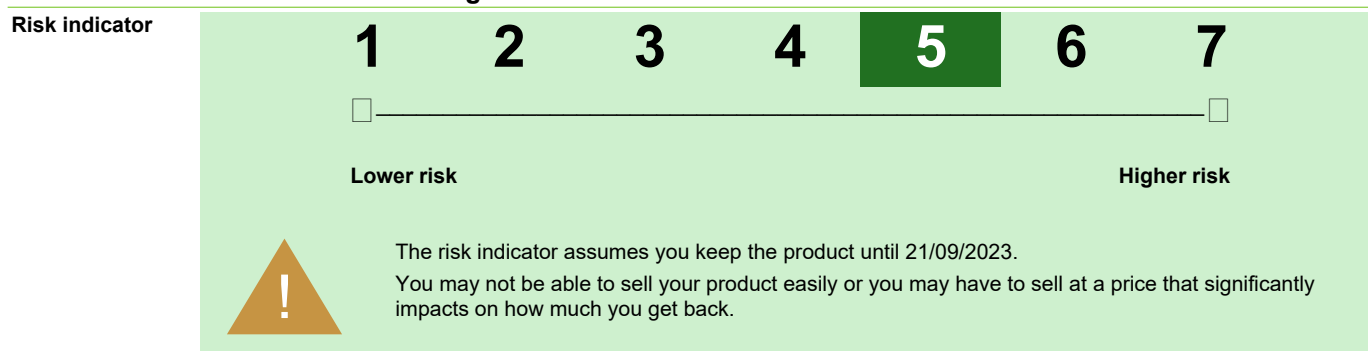

**Intended Retail Investor** The product C2009HYDRO is aimed at retail clients, who are interested in capital growth. The C2009HYDRO is a product for basic investors with basic knowledge and/or experience with financial products. The investor is able to bear losses (up to the total loss of the investment amount) and puts no emphasis on capital protection. On a scale of risk ranging from 1 (security-oriented; very low to low return) to 7 (very high risk tolerance; highest return) the product C2009HYDRO falls in risk category 5.

## What are the risks and what could I get in return?
